



The Justinian Mosaic in Ravenna, depicting the emperor in all his regalia

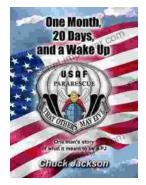
